ELECTION DAY INFORMATION from Town Clerk, John Myers:

The following Town of Buxton Departments and Town Hall Offices WILL BE CLOSED on Election Day, November 3, 2020: Transfer Station, Selectmen, General Assistance, Building Inspector, Plumbing Inspector, Code Enforcement, Planning Board, Board of Appeals, Town Treasurer, Payroll and Accounts Payable. These services will be closed to reduce motor vehicle and foot traffic, due to COVID-19.

FOOT TRAFFIC: ALL BUXTON VOTERS will enter the Town Hall from the right side of the building when facing the front of Town Hall and the left side of the building when in the back of Town Hall, the Building Inspector's hallway, on the Transfer Station side of Town Hall. Voters will move forward, down the hallway to the voting room as space becomes available. Voters must always maintain six-foot social distancing. Voters are strongly encouraged and asked to wear a face covering. After voting, all voters exit the back doors of the voting room to the back-parking lot.

The Registrar of Voters will be in session at the Buxton Municipal Building, 185 Portland Road, on Thursday, October 29 from 1:30PM to 4:30PM; on Friday, October 30 from 1:30PM to 4:30PM; and on Monday, November 2, from 1:30PM to 5:00PM; in order to receive new registrations, enrollments, and changes in name and address for the November 3, 2020 State of Maine referendum Election.

The first half of the tax payments that were due on October 10th that are still outstanding, will start collecting interest if not paid by October 30, 2020.
