- For Public Works employees holiday hours shall be included as hours worked for the purpose of calculating overtime. No other forms of paid leave shall be counted as hours worked. (Section Added)
- All Non-Union and Non-salary employees who are required to work on a holiday shall receive time and a half for all hours worked on the holiday, plus applicable holiday pay. (Section Added)

# **Public Comment and Questions**

<u>Dave Harmon-</u> You accidentally announced the meeting as the 24<sup>th</sup>, instead of the 27<sup>th</sup>. Last week you said there were maps of the coverage areas of the new communications system. I haven't received one yet. Can I get one.

<u>Scott Warchol-</u> Are the meetings with the DOT online or in person? Can I participate in those meetings as a Town liaison? There are many things we need to pay attention to like the length of time the project is expected to last. I believe it will take longer than they are forecasting. Also, there are many events and a parade that takes place during that time, so we would have to know how the detoured traffic would affect those events. I offer my expertise as a liaison to help represent the Town on these issues.

Selectman Blier- I believe the meetings are in person, we can look into it.

<u>Scott Warchol-</u> These openings on the committees and boards, it would be helpful to have them listed on the Town's website with a description of what those positions entail. Also, just a thank you and a reminder about the Keep the Heating Program that is available for low income seniors and disabled persons who are in need of heating assistance.

I would also like to bring attention to our great Aging in Buxton Program here in Town. Ellen Dacotis and Terri Warren started and run the program. They have recently received the AARP's approval as an age friendly community. The program was started in the spring of 2021 with a goal to aid seniors in Buxton which provides rides to medical appointments, and food boxes for over 40 seniors. They also recently participated in a housing grant with Biddeford and Saco to supply needed home repairs to needy seniors who needed minor repairs that they were unable to do on their own. They also worked with the Sierra Club to provide storm windows, to cut down drafts and provide warmth. They recently worked with local high school student volunteers to provide snow shoveling services. They have also worked with various agencies to provide better access to Buxton seniors to state and local programs. I would like to thank Ellen and Terri for all they do to help our seniors.

There is a meeting Saturday, January 27<sup>th</sup> of Aging in Buxton at the Saco River Community Theatre between 10-Noon, to work on issues and solicit volunteers. The snow day for that meeting is February 3<sup>rd</sup>.
