Public Comment and Questions

<u>Brian Berube-</u> Read statement concerning his property at 22 Ripple Ln, planning board decision, and appeal.

<u>Selectman Pulsoni-</u> We appreciate Mr. Berube's letter and comments to the Board. However, the Planning Board's denial of Mr. Berube's conditional use application is currently the subject of a pending appeal in the York County Superior Court. The Select Board does not comment on pending litigation, and therefore the Board will not offer any comments in response to Mr. Berube's letter.

<u>Dave Harmon-</u> Do you have an answer to the question about employees taking cars home and fringe benefits.

<u>Mark Blier-</u> Yes, we looked into it. At the end of the day, we rely on our auditing firm to let us know if we are out of compliance, and they have never said anything to us, so we will follow up with them.

<u>Dave Harmon-</u> When you allocated the money for the demolition at 60 Old Thompson, did you hold a special town meeting to approve those funds, or was it an order

<u>Selectman Poitras-</u> It was deemed an emergency situation, and the charter grants us power in an emergency situation.

<u>Selectman Pulsoni-</u> We had a public meeting with our attorney to declare it a health emergency and order the demolition. It was a public meeting, but not a special town meeting. It was deemed an emergency situation because of the health danger.

<u>Dave Harmon-</u> *There is not a flag at the Groville Monument, did someone take it down?*

<u>Selectman Pulsoni-</u> *We will make sure a flag is up.*

<u>Selectman Blier-</u> *Last week Lisa Crockett asked a question about the uniform costs at the Public Works. We provide uniforms to our public works employees. The shirts have our logo on them, but the pants do not. We give them a weekly stipend of 6.71 to pay for the costs of the jeans, and for the washing of the jeans.*
