Public Comment and Questions

Dave Harmon- You said December 13th on the Minutes, it should have been December 20th.

Selectboard- Sorry about that, you are right. We will vote to accept that now.

Dave Harmon- When the subject of the communications system was first brought up, it was said that we needed to update the dispatch center, because the old equipment would not work with a new system and tower. Now you say we don't need a Tower.

Selectman Blier- I don't remember exactly what was said at the beginning of the project. We have come a long way since then. The purpose of updating the system was to increase clarity and coverage throughout town. This would increase safety for our officers and the public. That was the reason we updated the 30-year-old equipment in the dispatch center, because it had started to fail. The tower was to increase our coverage and to eliminate dead zones throughout town.

Dave Harmon- I understand that, but they said that the old equipment wouldn't work with the new system, like the tower.

Selectman Pulsoni- Through the studies that RCM did, they evaluated what needed to be replaced to fix our problems. That's why we proceeded the way we did. When problems came up with the tower site, they came to our police chief and told him there may be an alternative that they discovered when they inspected some of the schools throughout the area and their fiber optic communications. Now we know that we can add some equipment to those installations and achieve similar results. The dispatch center will work with the fiber optics.
