Buxton Opens Saturday for Absentee Ballots

The Buxton Town Clerk's Office will be open on Saturday, October 22 and Saturday, October 29 from 9 AM to 3 PM as additional hours to issue absentee ballots and register voters for the November 8th Presidential Election, at the Buxton Town Hall, 185 Portland Road.

Absentee ballots can also be mailed out at the request of the voter by calling the Town Clerk's Office at 929-6171.

The last day for voters to request a regular absentee ballot is the close of business on Thursday, November 3rd, 4:30 pm for Buxton voters. After November 3rd a special circumstances absentee ballot application must be signed by the voter to receive an absentee ballot.

The polls will be open in Buxton on November 8th from 6:00 AM to 8:00 PM, at the Buxton Town Hall, 185 Portland Road.
